

Can you drive a motorhome on a car licence in Ireland or the UK?

Yes! At Retro Camper Hire, all of our campervans and motorhomes for hire in the Ireland and the UK are under 3500kg so can be driven with a normal 'B' car driving licence.

What sort of licence will I need to hire a campervan in Ireland or the UK?

To hire a campervan in the Ireland or the UK, Driver(s) must hold a full valid manual driving licence for at least 24 months that entitles you to drive a European category B vehicle or equivalent up to 3500kg GMW.

If your driving licence is not in English or issued in the UK or EEA or Switzerland, then an international driving licence is required. A certified translation may be accepted depending on the country where the original licence was issued.

How old do you have to be to hire a campervan in Ireland and the UK?

Drivers can be aged 21-80 years old to hire a campervan in Ireland and the UK, and all our rentals include fully comprehensive insurance for the driver(s). A young driver surcharge will automatically be added for those aged 21-24, which must be declared at booking.

Please note, we are unable to hire to undergraduates and/or students under 25 years of age.

What do I need to bring before I pick up my camper?

All drivers must be present for collection of your motorhome. You will **need** to bring the following to the rental depot before you pick up:

- 2 Separate forms of photographic ID (Passport & Driver Licence)
- Any accompanying documents with driver licence (i.e. counterpart)

• Can I drive my campervan to Mainland Europe?

- **Yes**, Retro Camper Hire vehicles are available to rent for driving through the Ireland the UK & Mainland Europe.
- If you are planning on travelling to Mainland Europe, please contact us with your plans on where you are travelling.
- **Vehicles cannot be taken to Europe without prior notice to our team. If you do so, this will invalidate your driving insurance and may result in legal action.**
